Stepwise Planning Process

1. Develop inventory and forecast of emissions
2. Identify a full range of possible actions
3. *Identify initial priorities for analysis*
4. Develop straw proposals
5. Quantify GHG reductions and costs/savings
6. Evaluate externalities, feasibility issues
7. Develop alternatives to address barriers
8. Aggregate results
9. Iterate to final agreements
10. Finalize and report recommendations

- Complete the Catalog of Potential State Actions
- Develop Initial Priority State Policy Options from the Catalog for Detailed Design (through balloting process)
- Review Preliminary Iowa GHG Inventory- Forecast Data, as available (SC Meeting #4)

Catalog of State Action Items

- Discussion of TLU Policy Options with Potential GHG Reductions and Cost Effectiveness Rankings
- Discussion of any Suggested Changes to Rankings
- Complete development of Iowa Catalog of State Actions [Decision Item]

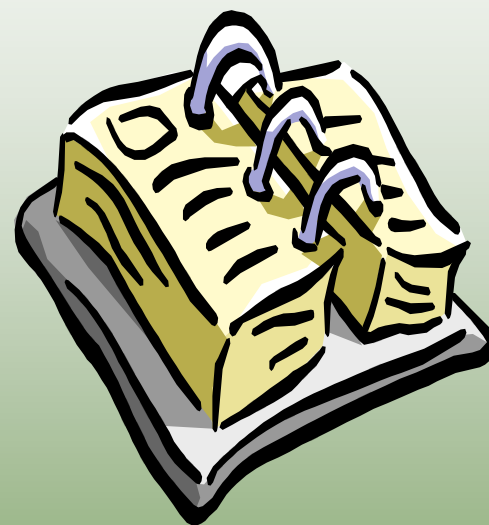
