Discussion items and key issues:

This was the second conference call of the IA CRE SC.

1. Tom Peterson of CCS called the meeting to order, asked call participants to announce themselves, and reviewed the agenda.
2. Members of the SC reviewed and discussed the Catalog, revised to include the existing actions in IA and suggestions from SC members regarding additional options that should be considered.
3. Tom explained the next step for the SC: to assign “notional rankings” to the catalog options of “high, medium, low” for both the “GHG reduction” column and the “cost effectiveness” column. This will help the SC begin to identify the top 10 or 12 options for recommendation to the ICCAC.
4. Gordon Dunn explained that the IA Utilities Board Energy Efficiency Study is due for release on January 1 and should be reviewed for its potential impacts on the issues being considered by this SC.
