5. Quantify GHG reductions and costs/savings - **Continuing**
6. Evaluate externalities, feasibility issues - TBD
7. Develop alternatives to address barriers - TBD
8. Aggregate results - TBD
9. Iterate to final agreements - TBD
10. Finalize and report recommendations - TBD

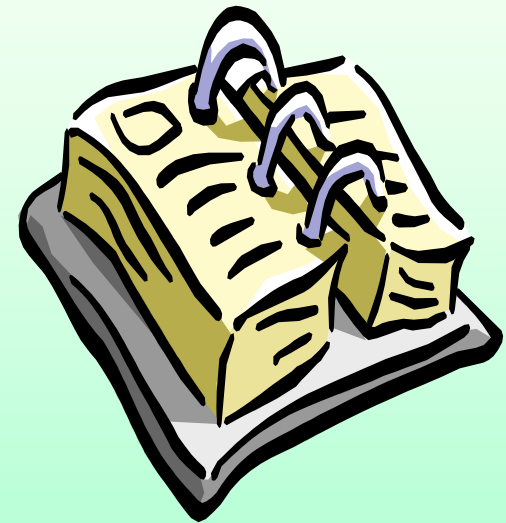
- AFW subcommittee incorporates ICCAC's recommendations into the Policy Options
