2. Identify a full range of possible actions - **Complete**
3. Identify initial priorities for analysis - **Complete**
4. Develop straw proposals - **Complete**
5. Quantify GHG reductions and costs/savings - **Complete**
6. Evaluate externalities, feasibility issues - **Complete**
7. Develop alternatives to address barriers - **Continuing**
8. Aggregate results - **Continuing**
9. Iterate to final agreements - **Continuing**
10. Finalize and report recommendations - **Continuing**

Results of September 3, ICCAC Meeting

- AFW options 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 were approved unanimously, noting that this approval is contingent on a few revisions to be made.
- AFW-1 was approved (with the majority of Council members voting in favor).
 - However, there were some concerns over the potential GHG benefits and the costs.
- AFW-2 was not approved (with the majority of Council members voting against).
 - Council members were not against the concept of a policy option focused on the improved management of wetlands/drainage but thought that from a greenhouse perspective, there may be alternative options that provide greater GHG benefits (or are less expensive).

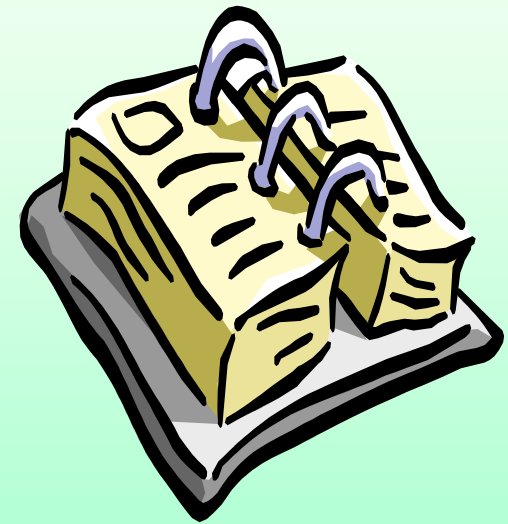
